Our vision:

We accept the scientific consensus that:

• global average temperatures have increased since the industrial revolution primarily as a result of burning fossil fuels;

• the world must urgently and drastically reduce fossil fuel use;

• the world must reduce greenhouse gas emissions to net zero as a matter of highest priority to maintain a climate suitable for human civilisation, plus employ strategies for drawing down carbon dioxide already emitted.

We demand our political and business leaders:

• do everything within their power domestically, and in international forums, to prevent global temperature increases exceeding 1.5 degrees C

• reduce Australia's greenhouse gas emissions in line with the targets of the Paris Agreement and successive international agreements

• prevent any new fossil fuel projects for Australian domestic or export purposes

Our code of conduct:

Be respectful:

- to members of the general public, including political opponents, even if they strongly.
- disagree with your statements or presence.
- to other members and supporters both at face to face meetings / events and online communications even when you disagree.
- to councillors, MPs and all relevant staff.
- Be inclusive and supportive.

We will not tolerate behaviour, either online or in person, which is:

- rude, aggressive, bullying or violent (towards people or property).
- sexual harassment of any type.
- racist, sexist, ageist, homophobic or otherwise discriminatory.
- putting anyone else in danger of harm or harassment.
