- Upgrading all of Council's Streetlights to LED, making this both cost effective and environmentally friendly and emphasizing our focus on creating a sustainable community
- Creating great shared assets in our area by investing in new green open spaces with our \$2.4 million inclusive Play Space at Burwood Park and our \$1 million Woodstock Sensory Garden to be delivered over the next 12 months
- Ensure that our investment in community safety through CCTV cameras and upgraded LED street lighting are effective in keeping our streets safe and act against illegal dumping
- Safeguard our environment and our community's future through delivering Burwood Council's 100% Renewable Energy Agreement
- Enhance our area's green spaces and increase our tree canopy cover with over 2500 trees planted in the past 3 years
- Continue to support environmental initiatives, being one of the first councils to use recycled rubber truck tyres as part of our road asphalting projects, greatly reducing landfill and creating a circular economy aiming to achieve our goal of a sustainable future for our community.
- Creating All-Inclusive Play-spaces like the \$1 million new Grant Park All-Abilities playground at Enfield which includes landscaping, native trees, BBQ facilities and an accessible amenities block
- Enhancing our community's connection to nature and recreation through the delivery of a \$4.5 million Nature Play Playground, Sensory Garden and Pond upgrade at Burwood Park
- Providing nearly \$5 million over the next 4 years for much needed open spaces. This will also
 complete expansion works started at Henley Park & Russell St Reserve which would add a further
 half an acre to open space.
